

Transfers

These are easily the most commented pieces of jewelry that I've ever worn. They are made with laser transfers onto the sheet of clay. They are fairly quick, tons of fun and a great introduction to transfers. I will provide the transfers, which are textures in Photoshop printed on a laser printer.

So what else can you do with transfers? How about transferring Dover clip art? Your kids' art? Your black and white photos? Your own photo line drawings?

So how do you color the transfers?

- Clay colors
 - Gold for antique photos
 - Beige for portraits
 - Pearl for ink colored transfers
- Colored pencils
- Alcohol inks
- Markers

I can bring all 3 so the students can try each one! I will also bring artwork to transfer.

What I would like to do, is demo how the transfer method, then have each student make one of the texture bracelets above.

Then I can demo the pencils, inks and pens and they can transfer and try any of these techniques also. I can also provide transfers for the students to use.

Of course, they can bring their own transfers as well, as long as they are laser prints (and they have to be reversed left to right so that they transfer correctly).
