

2016 Retreat Classes

Our special guest artist at this year's retreat is Lindly Haunani. She has more than 20 years of experience as a polymer clay workshop leader and has taught hundreds of workshops ranging from three-hour seminars to week-long residential intensives.



Her work has appeared in over 50 invitational and juried shows. She is one of the founding members of the National Polymer Clay Guild, co-author of *Artists at Work* and *Color Inspirations*, and the star of several how-to videos.

Here are the classes Lindly will be teaching:

Rainbow Ikat Inspirations

Learn how to make Lindly's version of an Ikat blend cane that uses extruded elements to intensify value contrasts that will make your cane really "pop".



Haunani Gane

Rainbow Haunani Gane – Glistening, gossamer, intriguing layers of polymer in a full rainbow spectrum characterize Lindly's version of this technique.



Each class is five hours – longer than the usual half-day classes we usually offer at the retreat. The **Rainbow Ikat** class will be on Friday, and the **Haunani Gane** class will be on Saturday.
