

Weed Pots

These silly birds are bound to make you laugh. Display your favorite dried flowers in their heads as the crowning touch. They are a favorite at my Studio 215.

Bring along your favorite canes if you have some or make some on the spot using your pre-made skinner blends. (I'll send you a prep sheet)

We'll be using serious scrap clay (the grey mud) for the center or we'll use fresh original Sculpey.

I'll show you how to use Stroppel canes to cover the body, so be sure to bring your "good" scraps too.

Warning! These guys are addictive and once you start making them you might not be able to stop.



Supplies

- Polymer clay canes of all colors and sizes. Lots of skinner blend canes, plugs and sheets recommended
- "mud", scrap polymer clay, conditioned and in sheets
- original white Sculpey
- dried flowers (optional)

Tools

- blade
- craft knife x-acto
- knitting needle - pointed on both ends - medium size
- Pasta Machine
